

# **FINANCE COMMITTEE**

## **LEWISTON, MAINE**

**Minutes of  
June 18, 2007**

**PRESENT:** Chairman Roger Provencher, Councilor Mark Paradis and Ronald Paradis.

Meeting was called to order at 5:16 p.m. by the Chairman Roger Provencher.

On motion of Mr. Mark Paradis , seconded by Mr. Ron Paradis it was

**VOTED:**

**(61-2007)** To dispense with reading of the minutes of the previous meeting dated June 4, 2007 and to accept and place them on file.

**VOTE: 3-0**

The Committee considered award of the bid for Randall Road Pumping Station Improvements. Bid proposals for this item were rejected several months ago because of lack of available funds. The new proposals received were within anticipated additional funding authorization from the City Council expected at the next City Council meeting. An Add Alternate for preparation and additional painting interior surfaces was being recommended for award based on the offer from the low bidder of a price of \$5,500.

On recommendation of the Purchasing Agent and on motion of Mr. Mark Paradis , seconded by Mr. Ron Paradis it was

**VOTED:**

**(62-2007)** Subject to approval of additional bond authorization from the City Council, to award Bid 2007-030 on the Randall Road Pumping Station Improvements to T-Buck Construction, Auburn, Maine, low bidder at their total bid price of \$438,129, including the Add Alternate.

**VOTE: 3-0**

The Fire Chief indicated that only one proposal had been received on the sale of the 1984 Pierreville Ladder truck. The only offer was received from the Town of Greene who offered a price of \$10,000 plus the salvage value of the truck that is currently in service by the Town of Greene. The salvage value of that truck is estimated at \$1,200. The Fire Chief also pointed out that the Town of Greene Fire Department currently provides mutual aid support to the City of Lewiston and this would provide benefits to the City of Lewiston.
