

LEWISTON ABSENTEE VOTING IN FULL SWING

LEWISTON - The Lewiston City Clerk's Office is pleased to announce the City's Early Voting Polling Place is open and ready to serve voters. *"Many voters already know how they are going to vote and do not want to wait until Election Day,"* said Lewiston City Clerk Kathy Montejo.

Numerous Lewiston voters are casting their votes by absentee ballot and with twenty-three days left to go before the statewide absentee voting deadline of November 3, the City is accommodating them with the establishment of the Early Voting Polling Place set up at City Hall (27 Pine Street).

From now until Thursday, November 3, Lewiston voters are welcome to come to City Hall Monday - Friday between 8:30am - 4pm and vote by absentee ballot.

The Early Voting Polling Place will also be open for evening hours on Thursday, November 3, until 7pm.

The City Council Chambers on the first floor is set up as a mini polling place with 14 voting booths to accommodate voters. *"Absentee voting is a great convenience to many residents and we are working to accommodate them as best we can. Allowing residents to vote at City Hall with 14 booths is making the process easy and welcoming for our residents,"* said Montejo.

Residents who are not able to come to City Hall to vote may request an absentee ballot over the phone by calling the City Clerk's Office at 513-3124 or may order one online via a link on the City's elections website at www.lewistonmaine.gov/elections

All of the City's regular polling places will be open on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, from 7am - 8pm. Residents with election questions may call the City Clerk's Office at 513-3124.
