Whereas, the City has been notified that it will be awarded a Grant of \$274,237.75 from the Center for Tech and Civic Life pursuant to the Grant Letter.

Now, therefore, be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Lewiston that the September 18, 2020 Grant of the Center for Tech and Civic Life is hereby accepted and up to the amount of the Grant of \$274,237.75 is hereby appropriated to be used for the election administration needs of non-partisan voter education, temporary staffing and any other categories as permitted by the grantor, during the period of June 15, 2020 to December 31, 2020 and that the City Clerk, City Administrator and City Treasurer shall receive the full amount of the Grant and use it for expenditures in accordance with the terms of the Grant Letter and to return any funds not expended pursuant to the terms of the Grant Letter to the Center for Tech and Civic Life.
