**PUBLIC HEARING AND FINAL PASSAGE FOR RE-ZONING OF PROPERTIES
NEAR EXIT 80 OF THE MAINE TURNPIKE AND ALFRED A. PLOURDE
PARKWAY TO ALLOW RETAIL AND SERVICE USES, IN ADDITION TO
INDUSTRIAL USES**

That the proposed amendment to re-zone the properties located within the following defined boundary - beginning at the southerly intersection of the Maine Turnpike/Exit 80 and Alfred A. Plourde Parkway, then south along Alfred A. Plourde Parkway to the intersection of Goddard Road, then west along Goddard Road to the Maine Turnpike bridge, then north along the Maine Turnpike to the point of beginning - from the Industrial (I) District to the Urban Enterprise (UE) District, receive final passage by a roll call vote.
