

Observations and Corrective Actions

Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below, or as stated in sections 8-405.11 and 8-406.11 of the Food Code

13: 3-302.11.(A).(1).(A): N: Raw Ready-to-Eat food not protected from cross contamination from raw animal foods during storage, preparation, holding, or display.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Raw breaded chicken held over RTE foods. Ready to Eat Foods must be stored over raw animal meats. Rearrange refrigeration unit so all RTE items are stored over the chicken.

14: 4-602.11.(C): C: Potentially hazardous food contact surfaces are not cleaned with proper frequency. At least every 4 hours.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Counters at breaded station are not cleaned and sanitized after use and have a build up of raw breaded and chicken. Wash and disinfect immediately.

20: 3-501.16.(A).(2): C: PHF not maintained at 41 F or less.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Reach in unit accidentally unplugged from power causing all top items to be elevated in temperature. All potentially hazardous foods must remain at 41* or below. *COS, discarded

47: 4-601.11.(C): C: Nonfood contact surfaces are not clean.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Shelving in coolers, door handles to coolers and reach in coolers have a build up of old foods and raw breaded caked to surfaces. Sanitize areas as needed and every 4 hours.

Violation Correction Timeframe

Critical violations should be corrected on site, but in any event, within 10 days. The licensee must contact your inspector, Laurie Davis when the critical violation has been addressed at 207-592-5573 or laurie.davis@maine.gov. Non-critical violations must be corrected within 30 days. Failure to satisfactorily correct these violations before the follow-up inspection may result in enforcement proceedings by the Department to include fines and penalties. License renewals can be denied if violations are not corrected within the noted timeframes.

C= Critical violation and NC= Non-critical violation

"Critical violation" means a provision of the Food Code that, if in non-compliance, is more likely than other violations to contribute to food contamination, illness or environmental health hazard.

Additional Inspection Fee

License fees provide for two inspections per year. When additional inspections are required, the Department may charge an additional \$100 fee to cover the costs of each additional inspection or visit.

Document Retention/Posting

Pursuant to the Maine Food Code, the establishment's current license must be displayed. In addition, a sign or placard must be posted in a conspicuous area notifying consumers that a copy of the most recent inspection report is available upon request. CFPM certificates must be posted in a conspicuous area and must be available to the Department upon request.
