INSPECTOR NOTES: Foods on salad bar and service line unprotected. Protect food by using sneeze guard or remove product.

45: 4-101.19: N: Nonfood contact surfaces of equipment that requires frequent cleaning not constructed of a corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent, and smooth material.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Masking tape being used in milk cooler on shelving. Masking tape is not easily cleanable. Remove masking tape.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Peeling and flaking paint in upstairs dishroom wall. Scrape and repaint wall to be smooth and easily cleanable.

53: 6-501.12: N: The physical facilities are not clean.

INSPECTOR NOTES: **REPEAT**Floors behind equipment are dirty. Clean floors and coving behind equipment.
