**LEWISTON:** The Lewiston Police Department has a new Deputy Chief. Police Chief Brian O'Malley has promoted Adam D. Higgins, a member of the Department since January 1990.

In addition, he has completed the Staff & Command Training Program at Roger Williams University, Rhode Island. Higgins has also been a member of the Lewiston Police Honor Guard for the last 27 years and has served as the department's Defensive Tactics & Taser Instructor.
