### **LEWISTON NOMINATION PAPERS DUE FRIDAY AFTERNOON**

With three days to go until the filing deadline for city nomination papers, half of the School Committee seats do not have official candidates.

As of close of business on Tuesday, Sept 5, the following municipal races on the Lewiston ballot do not have any qualified candidates running for these seats:

School Committee – Ward 3

School Committee – Ward 4

School Committee – Ward 5

School Committee – Ward 6

The deadline for interested candidates to file nomination papers to be qualified to run on the November ballot is Friday, September 8, by 4:30 pm. In order to qualify as a candidate, a person must be a registered voter of that ward, be at least 20 years old and submit nomination papers with a minimum of 50 signatures from registered voters in that ward.
